

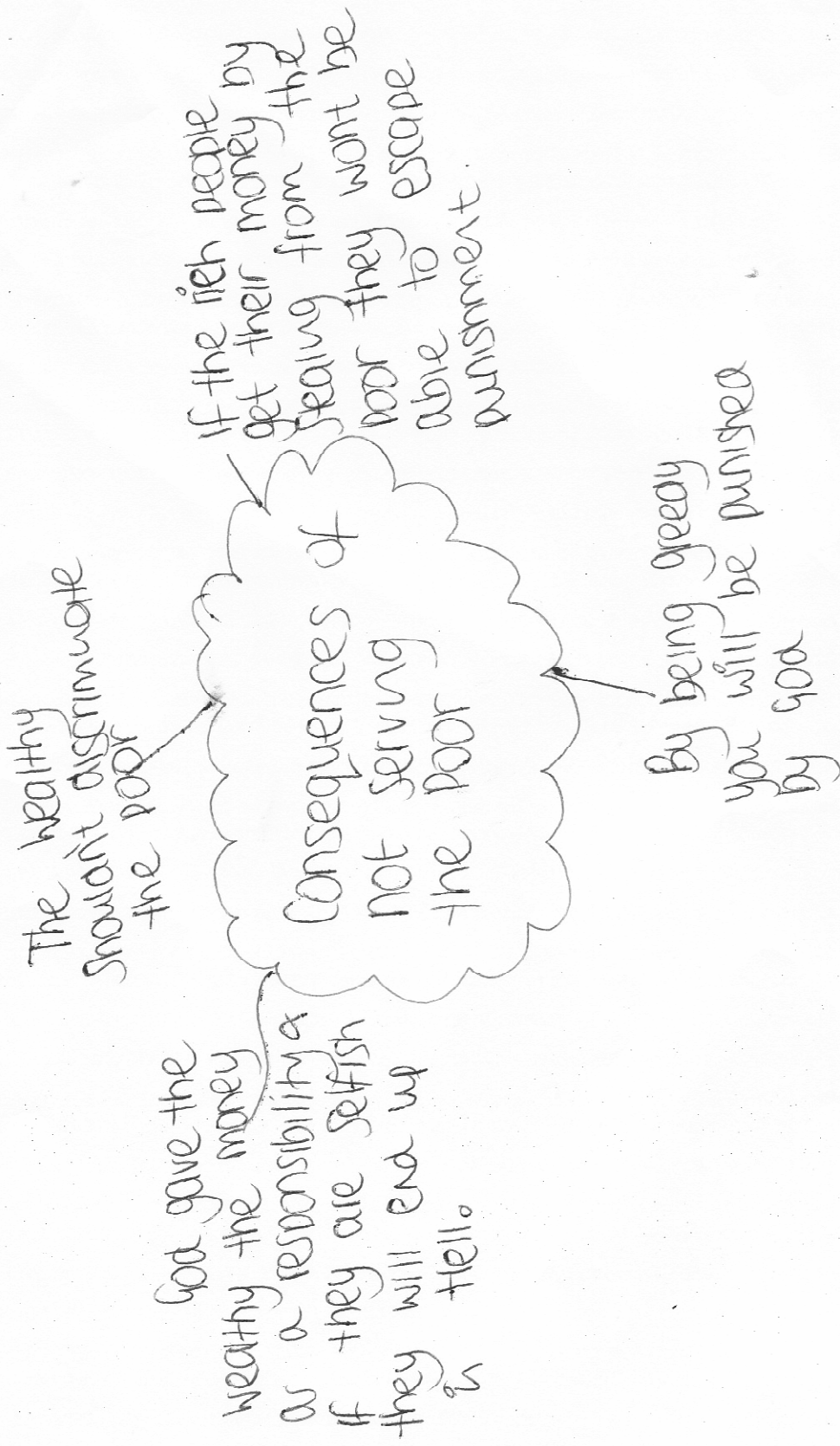
Consequences of not serving the poor:

- Ezekiel 16:49ff *I think it means that money corrupts people and makes them selfish and independent to others. I think there's saying they have forgotten God.*
- Isaiah 10:1-3 If the wealthy get their wealth by stealing from the poor they won't be able to escape punishment
- Luke 1:52ff 'He has brought down mighty kings from their thrones and lifted up the lowly.'
- Ezekiel 22:29-31 *He's saying the rich get rich through advantage of the poor & foreigners without helping or caring for them and that the rich are all selfish*
- Jeremiah 5:28f the wealthy shouldn't oppress the poor.
- James 5:1-6 By being greedy, you will be punished by God. 'You have made yourselves fat for the day of slaughter.'
- Luke 6:24 God will punish the rich.
- Luke 16:19-25 *He means that the rich are given money to use responsibly of the one who they will end up on hell even as the rich will end up in heaven closer to God.*

Obviously, adding to the misery of the poor is bad-- exploiting workers, oppressing immigrants, robbing the needy. But it doesn't stop there. Merely ignoring the poor is a crime.
